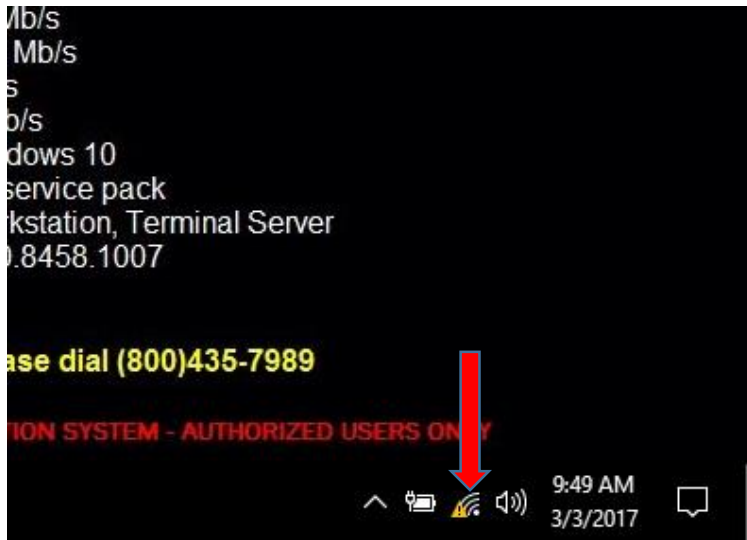
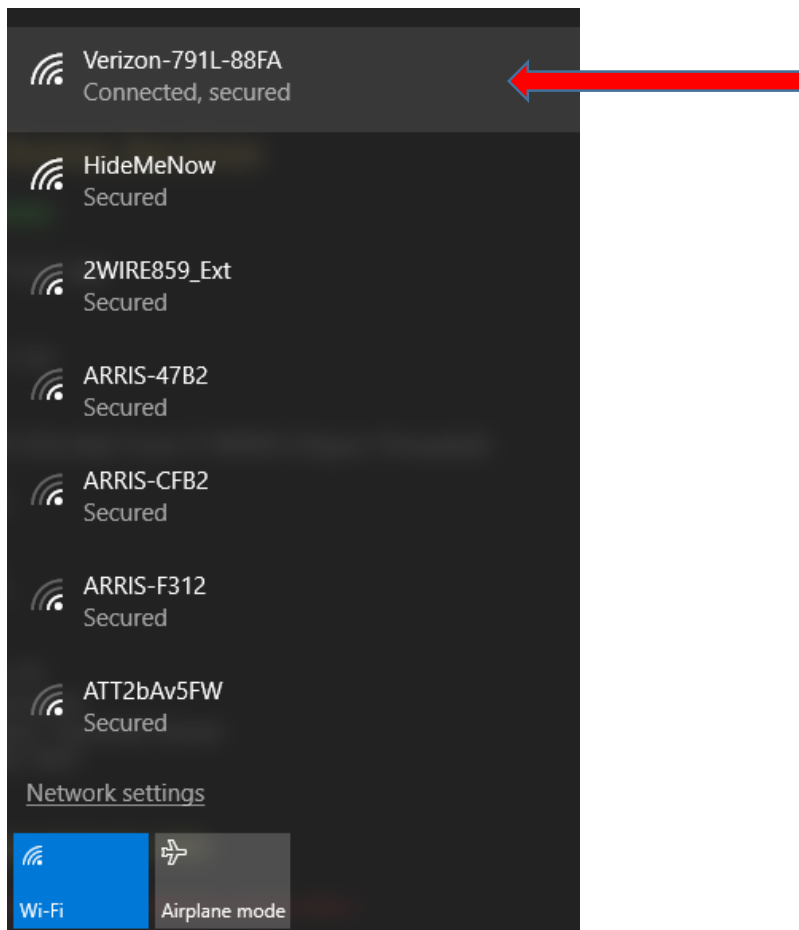


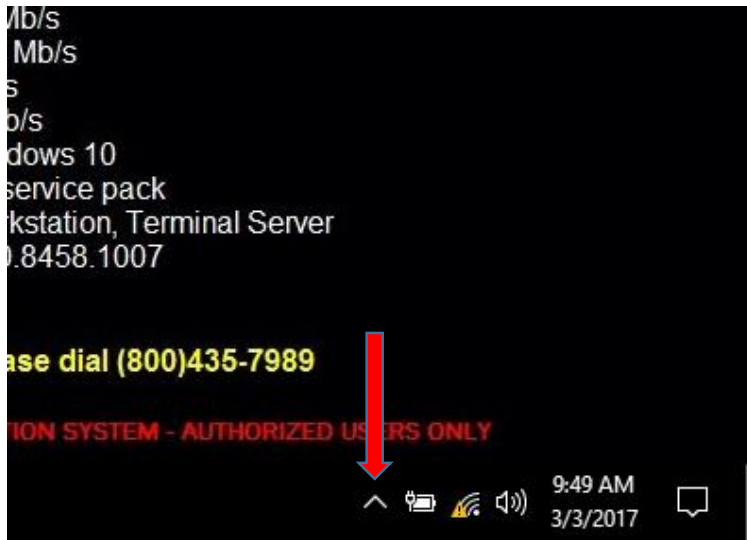
Getting Started off Network. At the far right bottom of the screen, you should see something similar to the picture below if you are off the Network. Notice the icon below:



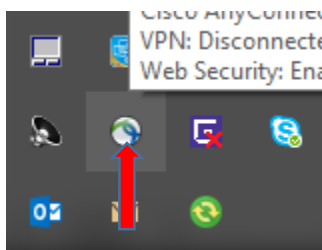

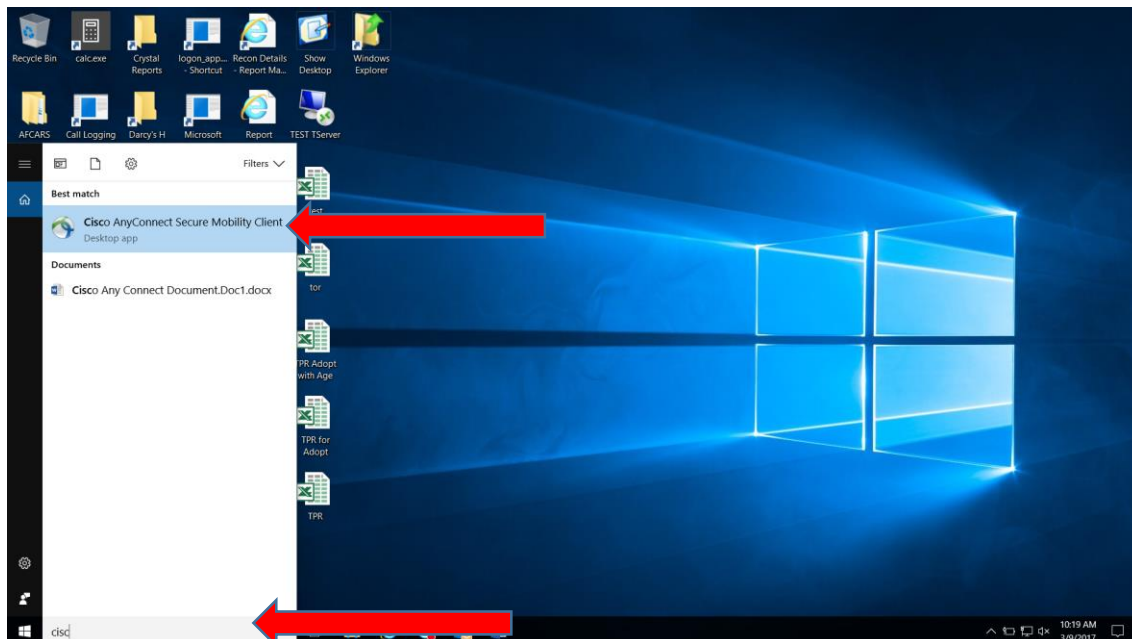
Click back onto the screen. You should see the icons in the bottom right again. Notice the arrow for the next icon. Click on the icon the red arrow is pointing to below:



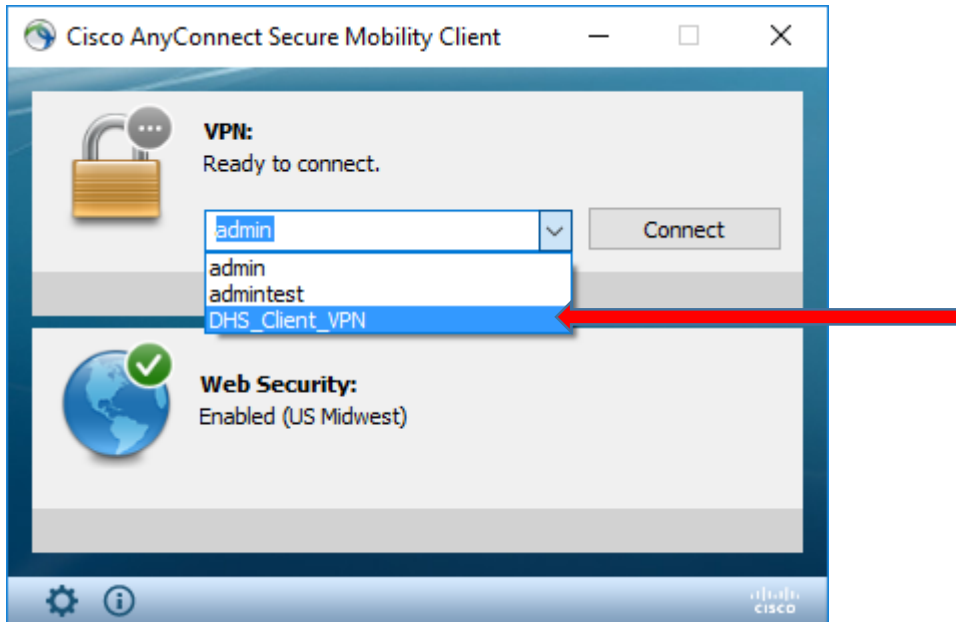
Find the below Icon. Click on the Icon the red arrow is pointing to below:



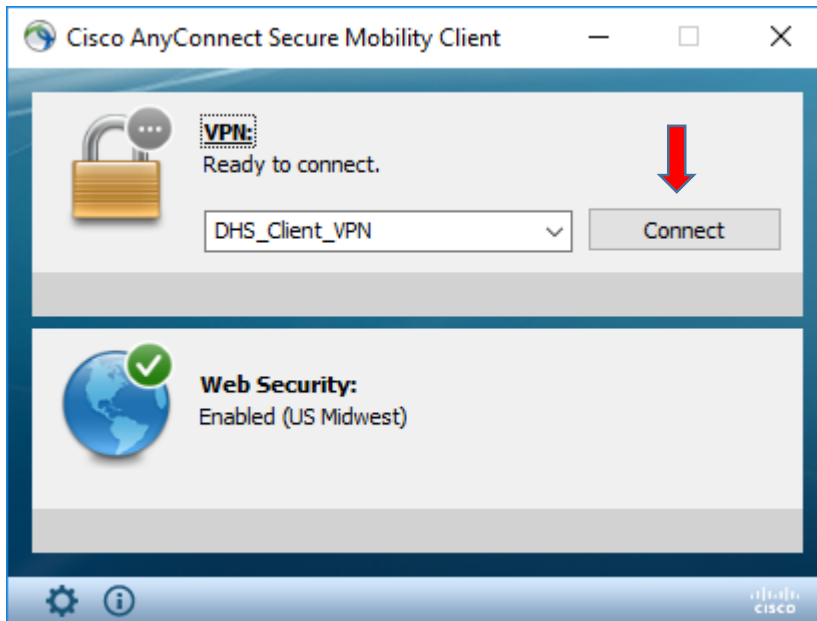

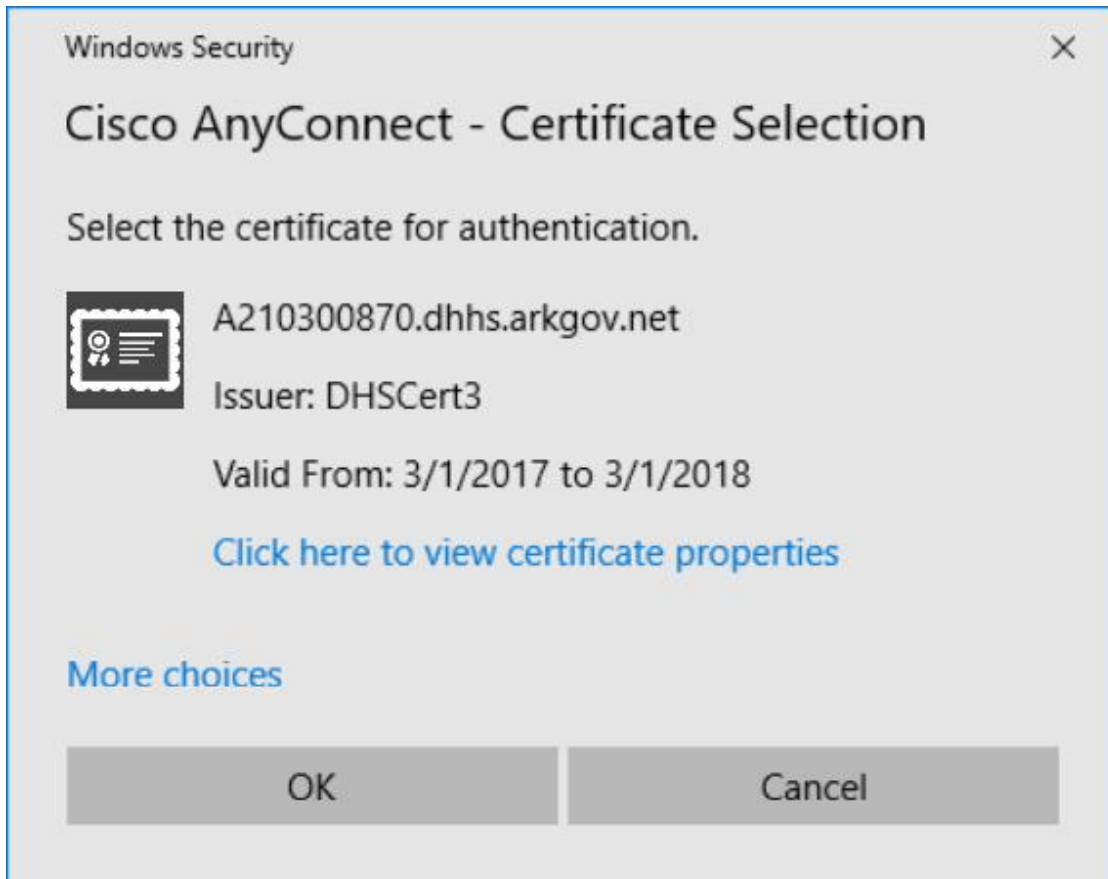
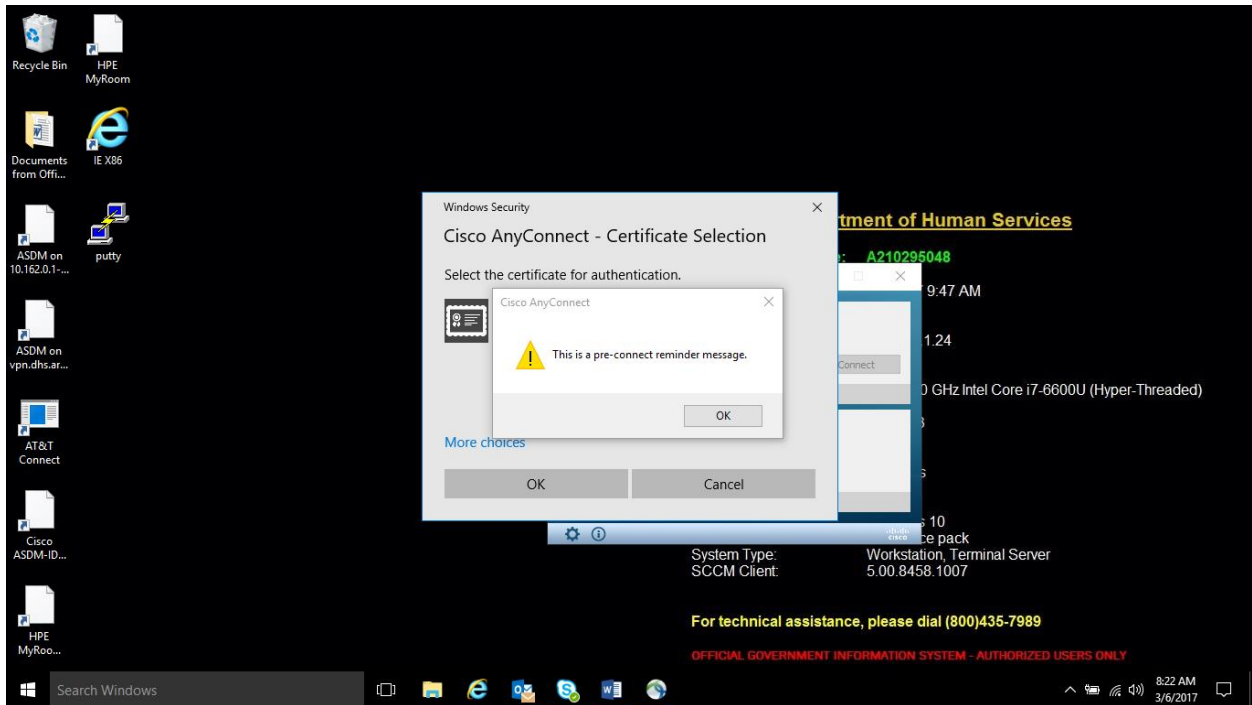
The following screen will pop-up. On the drop down box, select 'DHS_Client_VPN':



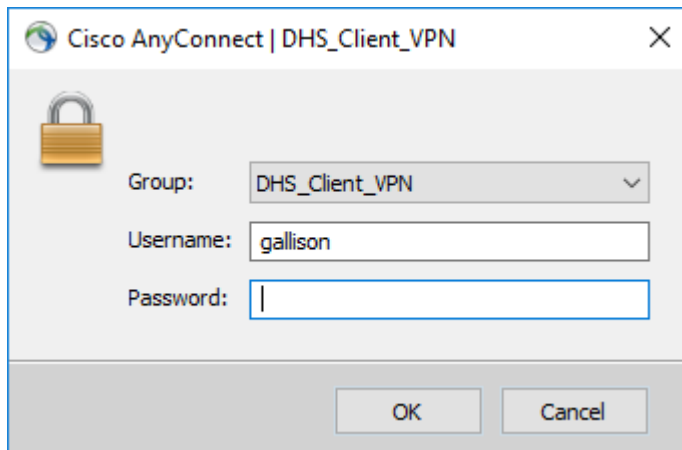
Click on **Connect**:



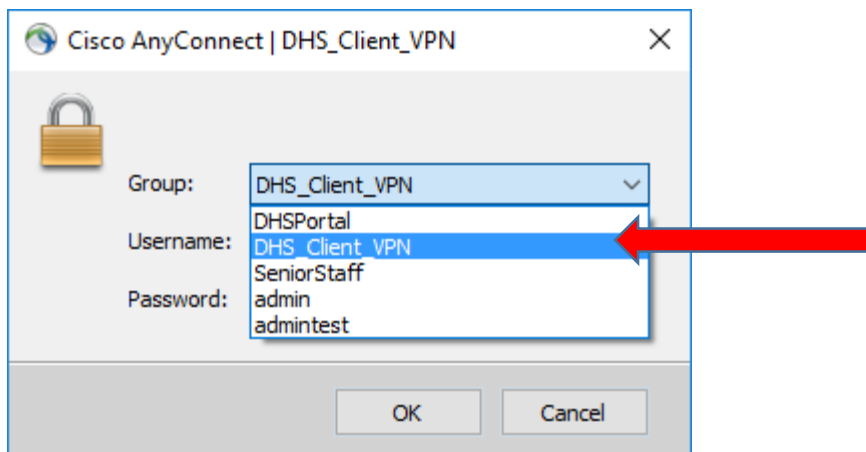
The following screens will pop-up. Click on OK on both of them.



The Cisco AnyConnect sign in will pop-up:

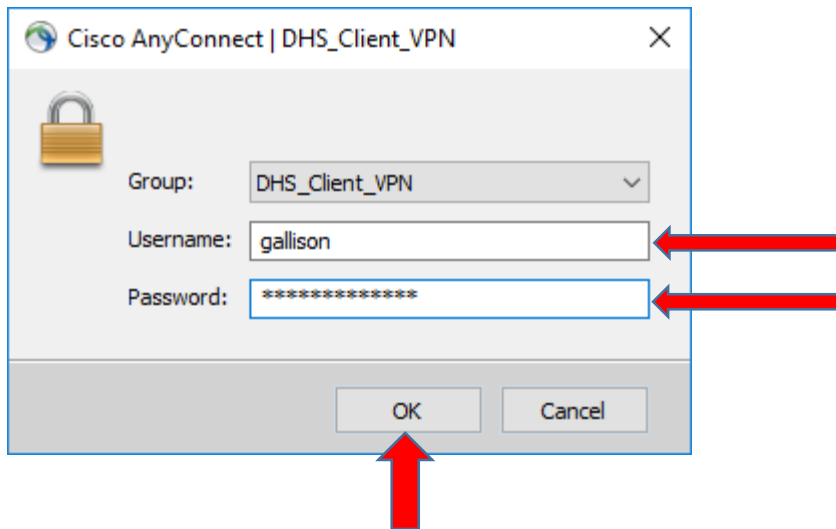


NOTE: Be sure 'DHS_Client_VPN' is selected as **Group** before signing in:

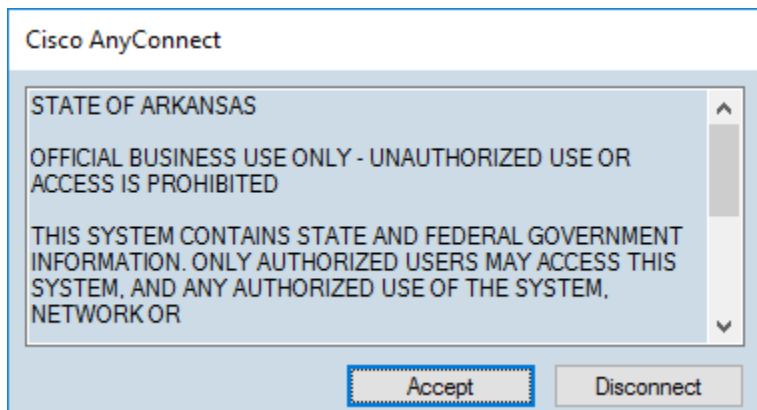


Enter your DHS Network Username (i.e. gallison). Note 'dhhs\' **does not** go in front of Username.

Enter your DHS Network Password and click OK:
