SUBJECT: Tier 1 and Tier 2 Rate Claims for CACFP Day Care Homes Notification

This is an important notification regarding the COVID-19 Child Nutrition Response #93 Nationwide Waiver of Area Eligibility for Family Day Care Homes (FDCH) for the 2022-2023 School Year.

Beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, the Food Nutrition Service (FNS) waived, for all states, the area eligibility requirements for Tier 2 to allow CACFP Day Care Home Sponsors to claim meals and snacks (served to enrolled children) at the higher Tier 1 reimbursement rate. **This waiver has been extended to cover July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023.**

CACFP Day Care Home Sponsors must log into their application, "CACFP Provider Agreement – FDCH1" and ensure they have chosen Tier I in preparation to receive the higher reimbursement rate through June 30, 2023, waiver end date. Failure to make the correct adjustment will result in an incorrect Tier rate claim reimbursement.
