SUBJECT: ADH BASIC FOOD SAFETY TRAINING IS NOW VIRTUAL

The Arkansas Department of Health has created a virtual training module for the Basic Food Safety Training. The 2024 ADH Basic Food Safety Training will be conducted online via Google Classroom. You must create a Google account to be able to access the classroom.

The Basic Food Safety Training is entirely virtual. The training will open at the start of each month. After opening, the training will stay open for 20-22 days and trainees must complete the Pre-test, all 10 Modules and quizzes, and then complete the Post-test. All module quizzes and tests need to have a passing score of 70% to pass the training.
