SUBJECT: NATIONWIDE WAIVER FOR SY 2021-2022

The following is extremely important information regarding Nationwide Waivers for SY 2021-2022.

These waivers take effect July 1, 2021 and end June 30, 2022.

#85 – SSO through 6/30/2022. Our NSLP on SFSP can switch to SSO when school starts.

#86 – SSO to claim SFSP rate.

#87 – NSLP and CACFP – non-congregate to June 30, 2022 – grab and go

#88 – NSLP and CACFP – meal-times flexibility waiver to June 30, 2022

#89 – NSLP and CACFP – parent pick up to June 30, 2022

#90 – NSLP – meal pattern – waivers: requirements for sodium, whole-grain, vegetable subgroups, milk variety, low-fat flavored milk, age/grade groups meal planning. **Need waiver request and approval.**

#91 – CACFP – meal pattern – waivers: daily whole grain requirement, crediting grains by ounce equivalent, can do low-fat flavored milk. **Need waiver request and approval.**

#92 – NSLP - waivers offer versus serve requirement in high school

#93 – NSLP and CACFP At-Risk, day care homes – waivers area eligibility; all day care homes are Tier 1.

Allows programs in any area to apply to participate. NSLP afterschool snacks can all be claimed at the free rate.

#94 – NSLP – State Agency and SFA monitoring can be desk audit and extend into the next year

#95 – CACFP – State Agency monitoring can be desk audit instead of on-site.

#96 – CACFP – Sponsor monitoring can be desk audit instead of on-site.
